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WHAT IS AI AND HOW CAN IT BE MISUSED?

- Definition of AI: AI, or Artificial Intelligence, is the simulation of human intelligence in machines.
- AI tools for cheating: Tools like ChatGPT can generate entire essays from a prompt, search websites and apps that can solve math problems instantly.

SIGNS OF AI CHEATING

- Unusual language or vocabulary
- Consistently perfect work
- Rapid assignment completion

TOOLS TO DETECT AI CHEATING

- AI detection: Grammarly and zerogpt both have AI detection built in
- Plagiarism checkers: Tools like Grammarly can identify copied content and pick up AI writing.
- Manual techniques: Reviewing consistency in writing style and language

DESIGNING ASSESSMENTS TO PREVENT CHEATING

- Open-ended questions- Questions that require personal insights and critical thinking.
- Oral presentations
- Updating assignments- Regularly changing assignment topics and questions to prevent reuse.

- Teach how to use AI responsibly

4. Emotional Intelligence and Soft Skills:

- AI lacks the capability to teach emotional intelligence and soft skills.
